By the end of KS2 the National Curriculum requires that pupils should be able to:

- play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression
- improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music
- listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory
- use and understand staff and other musical notations

This session offers practical, curriculum-aligned resources to enrich lessons and encourage pupils to take a more active role in leading musical activities. By strengthening subject knowledge and core pedagogical skills, the session empowers teachers to lead music with assurance and creativity.

The benefits are clear: higher-quality teaching; greater pupil engagement and independence; a stronger whole-school approach to music that supports curriculum intent, implementation and impact.

This session will help you to deliver high-quality music lessons whilst also allowing pupils to take an active part in leading parts of the sessions each week.

What the session will cover:

- How to teach pulse and rhythm confidently
- How to teach the different musical notes and their time values
- How to confidently teach rhythm using the rhythm cards
- How to use drum sticks to chair / table drum
- How to write a basic 4 bar rhythm composition
- How to teach an instrument in a whole class situation

To implement the ideas from the session, you will receive:

- Musical backing tracks
- Rhythm cards
- Sheet Music resources
- We will also provide drum sticks and pads plus recorders or glockenspiels for use during the practical section of the training.
