
WHERE IS MUSICA KIRKLEES?

Musica Kirklees teachers work in schools and centres throughout Kirklees.

Our base, which is home to our Office, Central Ensembles and some Central Classes, is at:

Richard Steinitz Building University of Huddersfield Queensgate Campus HD1 3DH

FINDING THE OFFICE

We are in room RSG/02 located on the ground floor of the Richard Steinitz Building.

The Office is open Monday - Friday, 9.00am - 4.30pm (hours may vary in the school holidays).



On entering the Richard Steinitz Building, turn left. You will find room RSG/02, the Musica Kirklees Office, on your far left near to the big window. Parents/carers are welcome to wait in the atrium during lessons and rehearsals.


ACCESSIBILITY AND SAFETY



The campus and Richard Steinitz Building are fully accessible for wheelchair users



We are close to Huddersfield Railway Station, Huddersfield Bus Station and several bus stops (timetables available at www.wymetro.com)



Please always use the pedestrian crossings to reach the campus.

The majority of the campus, including the area surrounding the Richard Steinitz Building, is pedestrianised and vehicle access is highly restricted (please see VISITING BY CAR section for details)



Assembly point 3 (area between Schwann Building and Laura Annie Willson Building)

If evacuating the building by:

- 1 Its main exit
- Fire exits from the stairwells and atrium area nearest university's main entrance
- 3 Exit and fire exit from the stairwell and the atrium area nearest Oastler Building
