




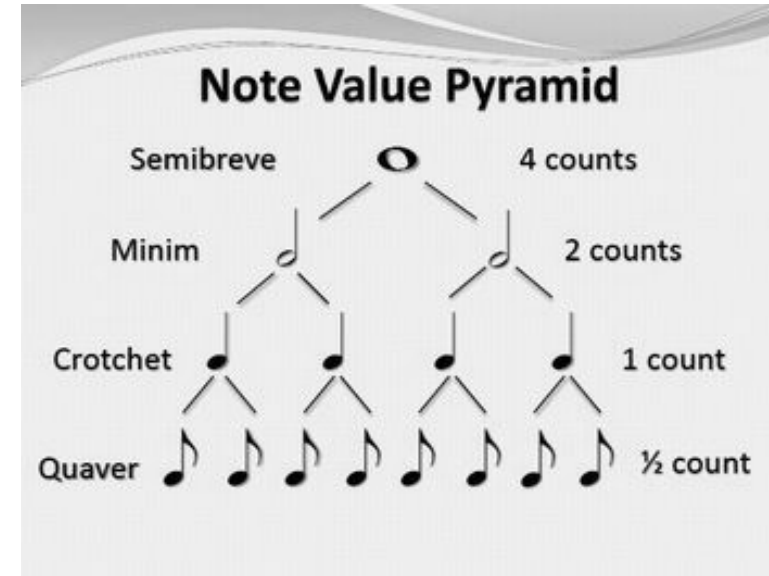
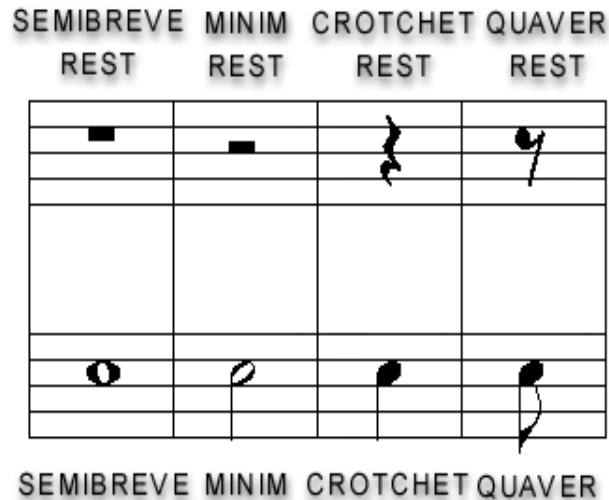


Note values and tips to help read rhythms.

British note names	Note symbols	Note value
Semibreve		4 beats
Minim		2 beats
Crotchet		1 beat
Quaver		1/2 of a beat
Semiquaver		1/4 of a beat



In the NYCGB video they use 1 & 2 & etc which is a great way of counting rhythm. If you are finding that a bit tricky sometimes using word patterns can help you memorise different rhythm patterns. These are some that I use in my teaching:

q – Tea



- Coffee



- Coca Cola



- blackcurrant



- lemonade
