

# E minor Groove

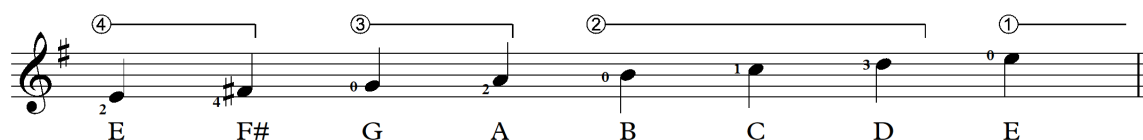

## Getting started

---

### Step 1

Learn your E minor Scale:



You can play these notes in any octave you like!

### Step 2

Choose a few of the notes from your E minor scale to make a motif (little tune). Use notes that sound good together and think of a cool rhythm which you like. If that is a bit hard at first, just noodle around on one note until you get more confident and add more as you go along.

### Step 3

Try playing along with the backing and have some fun with your ideas.

## Tips for success

---

- Make your melody more structured by having a start, a middle and an ending - just like a story!
- Don't be afraid to repeat your ideas and develop them
- Use interesting rhythms and rests along with a variety of different articulations too
- Feel free to extend your scale to include lower and higher octave notes
- If you're feeling bold, you could throw in a couple of 'spicy' notes from outside of the E minor scale
